

# PENINSULA RIFLE LEAGUE CLUB TEAM SHOOTING LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP 2019

In an effort to inform all interested parties and for the sake of clarity the conditions and rules specific to the Peninsula Rifle League Club Team League Championship for 2019 are defined in the following

### **Participants**

The Club Team Shooting League Championship is an inter club championship in which the competing clubs may enter and participate. Clubs may enter as many teams as they wish and the way in which the teams are selected and organised within each club is solely for the club to decide.

A person may not shoot for more than one club in this championship.

# **Program**

The league will consist of two rounds, A Qualifying Round and a Final Round.

# **The Qualifying Round**

In the qualifying round all teams shoot against one another in order to determine in which section each team shoots in the Final round.

This round will consist of three stages, weather permitting. In each stage each team will be allocated points dependent upon the position in which they finished in that stage. The points will be allocated as follows

The maximum number of points per team is based on a possibility of there being 8 teams taking part in the league.

Points are to be awarded as below

Team with the highest score – 8 points

Team with 2<sup>nd</sup> highest score – 7 points

Team with 3<sup>rd</sup> highest score – 6 points

Team with 4<sup>th</sup> highest score – 5 points

Team with 5<sup>th</sup> highest score – 4 points

Team with 6<sup>th</sup> highest score – 3 points

Team with 7<sup>th</sup> highest score – 2 points

Team with 8<sup>h</sup> highest score – 1 point

The points must be determined after each stage and published in the results of the stage.

After each successive stage a cumulative position per team taking part in the round must be established in which the points from the previous stages are added together and published in the statistics for the round, so that the position of the various teams taking part can be clearly seen.

At the end of the qualifying round the number of points accumulated by each team will determine in which competition the team shoots in the final round.

### **The Final Round**

The final round will consist of three stages, weather permitting.

This round is divided in to two sections viz. The League Team Championship and the League Team Plate.

In this round the teams finishing in the top half (or top two thirds if there is an odd number of teams) of the Qualifying Round will shoot against one another for the League Team Championship. The remaining teams will shoot against one another for the League Team Plate.

Points for this round must be awarded and accumulated in the same way as is done in the qualifying round with the exception that the maximum number of points per section is determined by the number teams in that section i.e. if there are 4 teams in a section the maximum number points per stage is 4 and if there are 3 teams in a section the maximum number points per stage is 3.

#### **The Stages**

Each round will consist of three stages as follows.

1st stage: - 10 counting shots each at 300, 500 and 600 metres

2<sup>nd</sup> stage: - 10 counting shots each at 500, 600 and 700 metres

3<sup>rd</sup> stage: - 15 counting shots each at 700 and 800 metres

# **Teams**

Teams may consist of 4 Shooters and a coach. In such teams the shooters and the coach must be nominated before the commencement of the shoot.

If a club cannot field a team of 5 as above they may shoot with 4 shooters who coach one another from within the team.

If a club cannot field a team of 4 shooters they may shoot with 3 shooters where the score of the shooter with the lowest score in the team may count twice. A club will not be permitted to exercise this option for more than 50% of the stages in any Round.

# **Prizes**

Five (5) medals will be provided for the winning team of The League Team Championship and The League Team Plate.

#### **Note**

- 1) Provision will be made for the coach in a 5 man team to shoot under coaching at each stage so that he or she may record a score for other matches and statistical purposes.
- 2) Should a coach for whatever reason decide not to shoot, he or she must still be accredited with having attended and taken part in the stage for dedicated sportsman purposes.
- 3) In all other matters regarding the conduct of the shoots and /or matches SABU rules apply
- 4) The committee reserves the right to change or amend any of the foregoing should circumstances make it necessary. People who are not in a team who wish to shoot may enter individually. Targets will be made available on which such people may shoot.
